The candidate must have made significant contributions in the field of Nuclear and Radiochemistry or Applications of Radioisotopes in any branch of Science. It may be noted that the award would be given for the research work carried out in India. (Please note: Those who applied last year for this award are also eligible to apply)

The awardee will be given an opportunity to present his / her research work as a short talk of about 15 minutes during the award function. The awardee will be provided Travel allowance (AC-II Tier train fare) to attend the award function, if he /she cannot arrange the travel funds from any other source. It may please be noted that the decision of the expert panel is FINAL, and canvassing in any form is a disqualification.

A declaration in this regard should be submitted along with the application. If the candidate has applied for a similar award and the result is awaited, kindly mention the same in the declaration.
